Antique coin box

The temptation is great to show people how it works. So beautiful.

Effect:

A wooden box is shown containing 10 Dutch 1 cent coins. Under each coin is a number from 1 to 10.



The magician leaves (can even leave the room) and the spectator may take 1 coin (or none) from the box and put it in his pocket.

The spectator may then close the box and call the magician back.

The magician places the box on the table and immediately knows which coin has been taken from the box.

Dimensions:

17.7 cm wide 11.6 cm deep 6.2 cm high

Information:

- The box may be thoroughly examined (really nothing to see)
- No use of Bluetooth or chips (didn't exist at the time)
- Very easy
- Very ingeniously made (certainly not serial work)
- With 99.99% certainty a unique piece that was made by a handy Dutch magician.
- The coins are Dutch 1 cent coins dating between 1951 and 1969.
- The box was therefore certainly made after 1968.
- This box is from the early seveties and therefore more than 50 years old.
- In perfect working order.
